§ 112-1. Authority.

This chapter is enacted pursuant to the authority of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and shall be known as the "Games of Chance Law of the Village of Vernon."

§ 112-2. Definitions.

The words and terms used in this chapter shall have the same meanings as such words and terms have in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York.

§ 112-3. License required; Sunday games.

- A. Games of chance may be conducted in the village by an authorized organization, after that organization obtains a license therefor, in accordance with the provisions, requirements and limitations of Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York as well as the rules and

regulations of the New York State Racing and Wagering Board and this chapter.

- B. The conduct of games of chance on Sundays is authorized, except as otherwise restricted in Article 9-A of the General Municipal Law.

**§ 112-4. Enforcement powers and duties.**

The powers and duties set forth in Subdivision 1 of § 194 of the General Municipal Law shall be exercised by the chief law enforcement officer of the Village of Vernon.

**§ 112-5. When effective.**

This chapter shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State after approval thereof by the voters of the village voting thereon at a general village election to be held pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.<sup>1</sup>
